## **Khongnangthaba University**

The Khongnangthaba University is established as the First Private University under the Manipur Private Universities Act 2021 (Act No. 6 of 2021). The fundamental objective of the establishment of this University is to promote and foster both modern and traditional knowledge through the curriculum of academic ventures. The Khongnangthaba University is recognised by the University Grants Commission as a highest educational institution under the section 2(f) of the U.G.C. Act 1956 in June 2022. And again, under the Section 22 of the U.G.C. Act 1956 the University is empowered to award diploma, graduate, Postgraduate and PhD degrees to the students.

The banner of this University is named after One Lourembam Khongnangthaba an eminent scholar of 18<sup>th</sup> century who was widely considered with highest degree of respect as a peculiar type of personality having the character of an extra ordinary qualification of scholarship. He was deeply acknowledged as a great fire brand flag bearer for the protection and promotion of traditional knowledge, culture and religion of the land (state) against the repeated silent invasion of foreign culture and religion. By standing on his conceptual platform this University is established with an objective to explore and enhance the framework of the national educational curriculum.

By acknowledging the modern educational concept and facilities provided by the colonial administration the British rule and also by realising the negative impact of the policy of the deliberate ignorance about the importance of the merit of the traditional knowledge system, the Khongnangthaba University, as a matter of policy, have decided to foster the knowledge and the oriental outlook of this region through the academic foundation. One of the basic objective of the University is to narrow down the gap between modern and traditional knowledge to the highest degree of maximum level by integrating the expertise of traditional resources and knowledge into the present framework of educational initiative. Indeed, the only aim of the Khongnangthaba University is to provide a conducive academic environment with an objective to develop the quality of skill and intellectual knowledge through intensive research work.

Besides, the Khongnangthaba University also aims to expand its academic horizon by constructing an intellectual bridge through the exchange of ideas between the concept of North-East India and South-East Asia. One of the basic outlooks of the University is to develop a centre for the exchange of culture and other related elements and to promote a dynamic environment where the students could embrace. Through these academic ventures the University aims to develop an intellectual forum through the establishment of a connecting line between the heritage of Manipur and South East Asian Civilisation within the broader fabric of academic platform.



The main mission of Khongnangthaba University is to make this institution a beacon of knowledge and a hub of cultural exchange through the system of transformative education. The University is always looked forward to produce the level of students who are fully committed in research and also in the process of nurturing and preservation of traditional knowledge system.




### **Infrastructure Overview:**

Khongnangthaba University committed in the creation of a conducive academic environment through the state of the art of infrastructure. **Eligibility Criteria for Admission to various courses:- PhD, MSc, MA, M. Com, BSc, BA, B. Com, Diploma and Certificate Courses:**

Subject to the conditions stipulated in this Ordinance, the following personnel are eligible to seek admission respectively to the PhD, MSc, MA, M.Com, BSc, BA, B. Com, Diploma and Certificate Courses, including mass communication, management and computer courses:

Candidates shall have a Master's degree or equivalent degree for pursuing a PhD, a Bachelor's degree or equivalent degree for Master's degree courses and intermediate or equivalent courses for Bachelor's degree courses recognised by the regulatory body of this university in a relevant/allied (as defined by BSD and approved by the BSS) with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC – 7 Point scale or an equivalent degree from any educational institutes approved by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency established or incorporated under a law in its home country statutory authority in that assuring quality and standards of educational institutions.

A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/differently-abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the commission from time to time, or for those who had obtained their Master's degree prior to 19th September 1991.

In order to encourage research, Part-time research leading to PhD will be allowed provided all conditions mentioned in the extent PhD. Regulations are met.

**Procedural Nature for Admission:**

The University shall admit a student to the PhD, MSc, MA, M. Com, BSc, BA, B. Com, Diploma and Certificate Courses including Mass Communication, Management and Computer Courses through an Entrance Test to be known as the Qualifying Entrance Test (QET). However, QET may be exempted for the candidates for the PhD programme who fulfill one of the following conditions:

- (i) A candidate who has qualified UGC-NET/UGC-CSIR NET/DBT-BET/ GATE/SET/SLET or has passed M.Phil. Programme.
- (ii) A regular employee of any University/Institution/Government Department/ Public Undertaking/R & D organization with at least 2 years of experience after the probationary period who can obtain No Objection Certificate (NOC) from his/her employer for pursuing the PhD. Programme with an undertaking that he/she will be relieved from the duty during the PhD. Course Work period, if selected for the PhD. Programme.
- (iii) A foreign national who is a recipient of a fellowship of the Government of India and/or who is sponsored by his/her government or self-financing foreign national.
- (iv) A candidate who is already registered as a PhD scholar in

some other Universities/Institutions, if his/her Supervisor joins this University, shall be required to work under the same Supervisor and governed by all provisions of this Ordinance except exemption from undergoing the PhD. Course Work under the provision of Clause 9.8.

The QET shall be of 2 hours duration. The syllabus of the QET will be uploaded on the University's website. The question nature and modality of the entrance exam will be notified/announced well in advance before such exams.

**Reservation of the Seat:**

1. The guidelines of the State Educational Institutions' Reservation Norms shall be followed to at the time of admission as amended from time to time.
2. In the case of regular teacher and employee candidates of Khongnangthaba University, they shall be treated as supernumerary candidates and allowed to enrol on any courses without appearing in the admission test.
3. One (1) seat in each Department is reserved for the son/daughter of the regular employees of the University on a supernumerary basis, provided he/ she shall fulfil the minimum eligibility criteria.
